Allamakee County Relief Services provides assistance to people in need of immediate assistance or people who cannot obtain assistance from any other source.

Assistance is provided to an individual who has income or benefits delayed from a state program or not actually received because not attributable to the person, and who does not have liquid assets of the family unit to pay for the items of assistance that can be provided. Kinds of assistance available include emergency assistance for those in need. Allamakee Relief Office provides assistance to people who need help with rent, food, medical, utilities, fuel, and medication. The assistance program is designed to provide short-term emergency type assistance to persons lacking the resources to meet their basic needs. Seasonally also offers pool passes, back-to-school shopping passes, and assistance at Christmas.

To apply, call the office to schedule an appointment. When you come for your appointment you will need to bring the following information: documentation of income, Social Security card, bills that you pay monthly, and any other information regarding your monthly situation.

Allamakee County Veterans' Affairs Office works with honorably discharged veterans, their spouses, and eligible dependants to assist in making application for a wide range of benefits to our veterans, service members and their families. Help includes assistance filling out a large array of forms for pension, compensations, grave markers, burial benefits, life insurance, and health benefits; to request military records/medals; and much more. Also provides temporary emergency assistance for basic needs to veterans and their families including assistance with rent, food, burial, utilities, and emergency medical care. Allamakee County Veterans Affairs also coordinates a van that travels to the Iowa City VA Medical Center Tuesday through Friday, picking up from five different counties. Call the office to schedule transportation. Also available is the help of a contracted licensed counselor to provide local counseling for veterans and their spouses. These services are available three days per month in Waukon.

Advocacy for Iowans under age 18 in issues of Child in Need of Assistance actions (child welfare), juvenile justice (delinquency matters), emancipation, infant toddler court program, minor crime victims/witnesses, involuntary mental health or substance abuse committals, minor guardianships, Young Motherhood Program and Too Good to Lose ("Girls Court"). They do not represent children in child custody cases between parents; for legal representation for a child in a custody matter contact the Iowa Center for Children's Justice.
